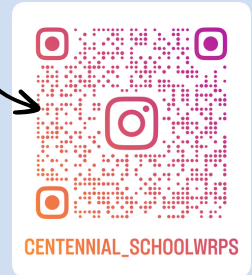


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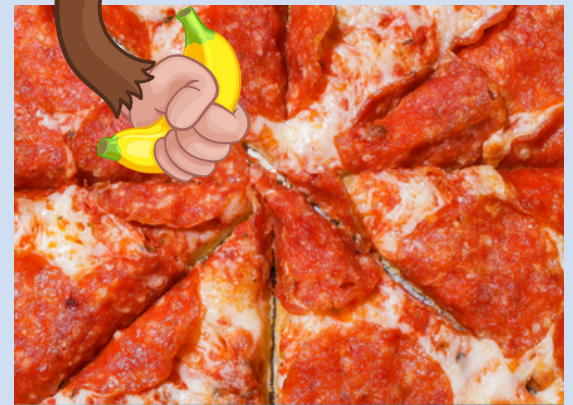

Congratulations go out to our grade five students for winning the Remembrance Day Poster Contest sponsored by the Royal Canadian Legion. Great job girls!!

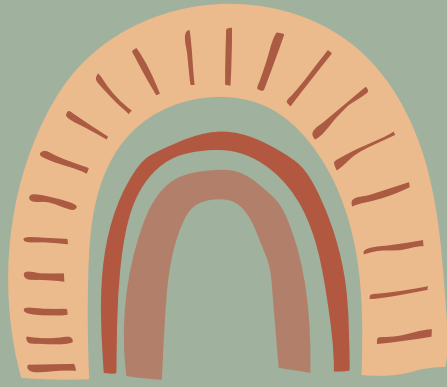

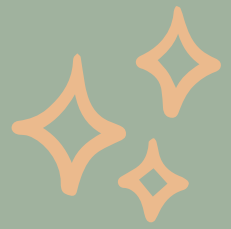

## What is this study about?

The ISSP is an early intervention and prevention initiative that is intended to provide essential services to address a variety of needs in diverse elementary schools. It aims to provide wraparound school supports which may include a positive police presence, on-site mental health worker, physical education teacher, social, access to a health clinician, breakfast and lunch programs, and after-school programs. - Understanding how well this program is serving your child's school.
- Having a voice in the programming as the information collected about the program will be used to inform future improvements.
