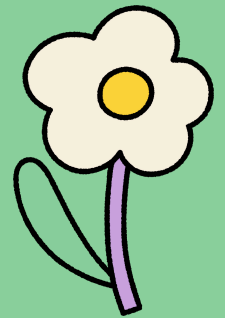
Tuesday, April 30th - Guest Readers

Beginning at 1:15 - there will be a GEOGRAPHY CHALLENGE for students in grades 4/5/6 testing their knowledge.

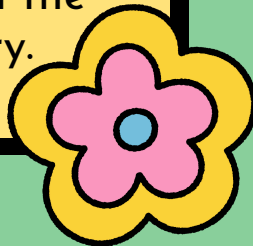


Wednesday, May 1 - Alberta Musical Theatre Company presents "CINDERELLA". The performance starts at 1:30 pm

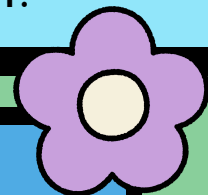


Following morning announcements each day - there will be a MYSTERY READER

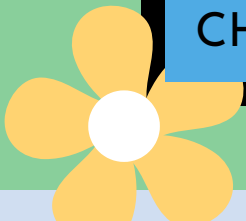
Students guess who it is and place an entry in the draw bin in the library. Good Luck!!

Friday, May 3 - STAFF/STUDENT SPORTS CHALLENGE in the gym from 2:00 - 3:00 pm

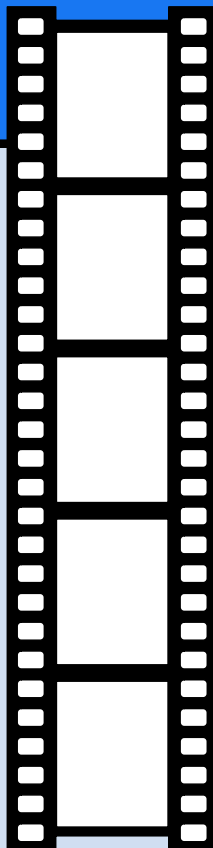


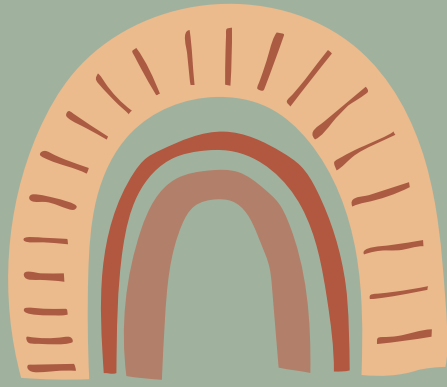
PARENT COUNCIL MOVIE NIGHT

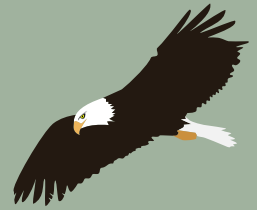
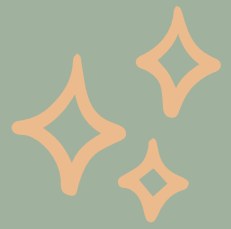
