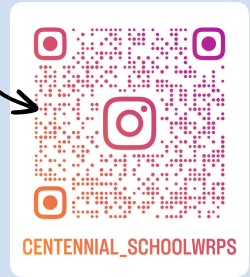

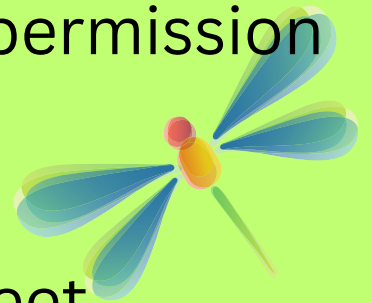

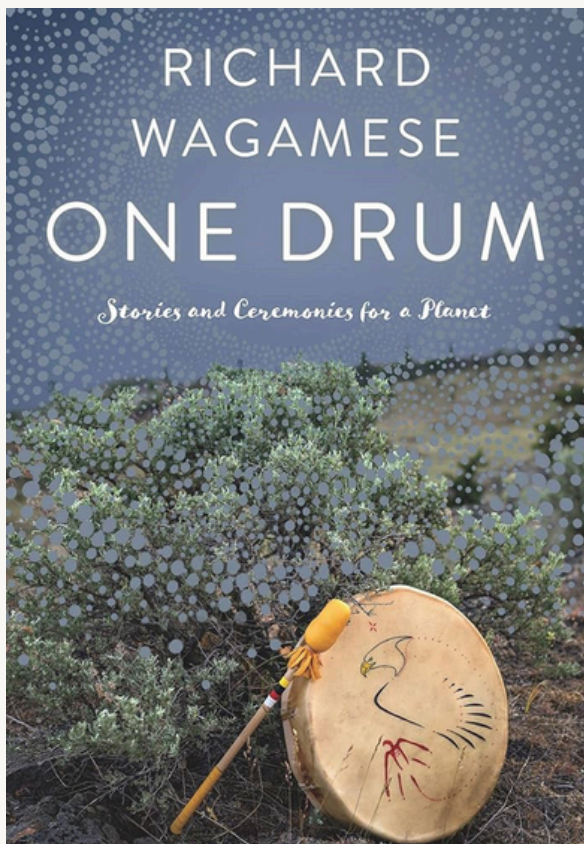

## Lance Scout - One Drum Teachings

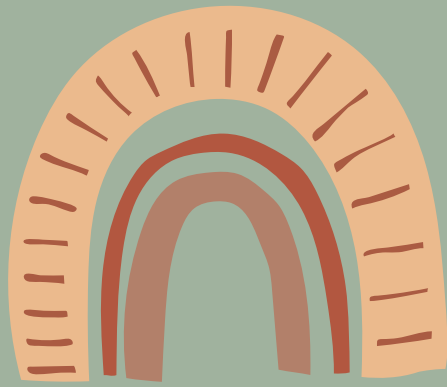

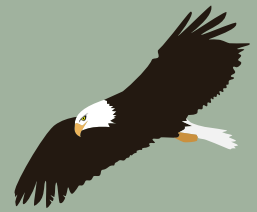
Our last teaching centers on Acting Outwardly with the guiding questions of 'What am I willing to give? What is in it for me?'



Indigenous Ways of Knowing are explored and embraced in this project which highlights the worldviews and understandings of Indigenous peoples on Turtle Island. Students gain an understanding of their own lived experiences through self-exploratory discussions and creative, practical, and collaborative assignments that reflect the student's heritage. Taught in a traditional circle space reflecting the earth, stars, moons, and our life cycle, promoting equality and belonging.
